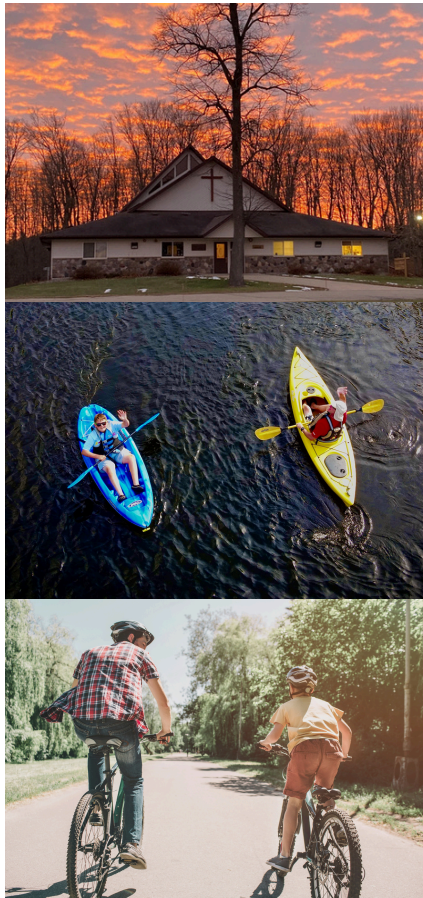




HOMME YOUTH AND FAMILY PROGRAMS

Since the founding of the agency in 1882, Homme Youth and Family Programs has been committed to each child as an infinitely valuable individual.



Treatment goals today are tailored to each youth, serving males ages 10-18, with an emphasis on trauma-sensitive care. Homme provides 24-hour sight and sound supervision to youth with emotional and behavioral challenges. Elements of our program include:

- Sex offender specific treatment for youth with sexually reactive behaviors
- Therapeutic modalities in use include Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing, Dialectical Behavioral Therapy, Motivational Interviewing and Expressive Art Therapy
- Aggression Replacement Training
- On-site alternative programming for youth who act out
- Indoor and outdoor recreational opportunities
- Individualized treatment for cognitively disabled youth
- Fully accredited, on-campus school
- Performing Arts Workshop with two performances annually
- Evening Trauma Therapist to address struggles after business hours
- Medication management to address mental health needs
- Community service opportunities
