Funding

Services provided are funded through our county partnerships with Department of Health Services. LSS Aspen Center is also licensed to provide services under Residential Substance Use Disorder Medicaid. This option requires individual counties to cover **only** cost of room and board.

Costs	
Medically Monitored Treatment (includes room and board)	\$237.00 /day
Transitional Residential Treatment (includes room and board)	\$144.98 /day

Room and Board rate for Medicaid eligible clients	\$56.20 /day
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Licensed LSS counselors and case managers partner with individuals and their loved ones seeking treatment to craft an individualized, strength-based plan for recovery. Treatment plans address all areas affected by addiction, including: relationships, trauma, mental health, employment, education, spirituality, attitudes, and leisure activities. Individuals drive their plan and examine each of these areas to create holistic lasting change for themselves.

LSS addiction treatment works, recovery is attainable, and relationships can be repaired or rebuilt. Change is difficult and takes time and practice. Our 40+ years of experience targeting the many pathways to recovery provides the baseline of hope that is the essential first step on the journey of change and restoration.
